In Gashora, the new health center replaced the small and debilitated facility that previously existed. The new facility will provide services to 22,000 residents who live in the vicinity. The new health center will also contain a community center including a library and computer resource center that will be available to members of the community.

In Ngeruka, the new facility is filling a previous gap in health care services and now provides these services for 27,000 people. The health center will provide advanced services for prenatal and natal care.
